Meditation: Manifesting Abundance Through Godly Imagination



Dear Friend

Genesis 1:26-27 says: "And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them". God created man differently from the way he created everything else. When He created light for instance, the Bible says He said, Let there be light, and there was light. However, when it came to mankind, God the father had a vision and He shared it with the Godhead. He said, Let us make man in our image. The word image here is also translated imagination. In other words He said let us create man in our imagination and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, the things that creep on the earth and the birds of the sky. This was the model man. It's interesting to note that we still follow the same process in our creation today. Everything invented starts as a picture in our minds. Everything you see in life today started as an imagination in someone else's mind. Genesis 2:7 says: "And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul." After the Lord had created us in His imagination, He then formed us physically to become a living soul. He used the model version to create the physical version.

Your imagination is powerful and can create your future

Genesis 11: 1-8 says: "And the whole earth was of one language, and of one speech. And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east, that they found a plain in the land of Shinar; and they dwelt there. And they said one to another, Go to, let us make brick, and burn them thoroughly. And they had brick for stone, and slime had they for mortar. And they said, Go to, let us build us a city and a tower, whose top may reach unto heaven; and let us make us a name, lest we be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth.. And the Lord came down to see the city and the tower, which the children of men builded. And the Lord said, Behold, the people is one, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do. Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech. So the Lord scattered them abroad from thence upon the face of all the earth: and they left off to build the city". The bible said nothing could be restrained from them which they had imagined to do. This passage of scripture illustrates that man's ability to accomplish things is linked to his imagination. The imagination is the conception chamber for creativity. Our imagination is so powerful, it can create our future. The word imagination used here is the Hebrew word yester which means conception. This is the same word translated as mind in Isaiah 26:3. "Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee". The imagination is the part of the mind that conceives things.

Other peoples testimonies can help engage our imagination and inspire us but it should not stop there.

The bible has so many stories written to show you and I that there are no barriers in life. There are just faith targets. Romans 15:4 says: "For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope" We can therefore read the stories about people like Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Esther, Jesus and Paul and be inspired to dream bigger.

The Word of God must paint on the canvas of our imagination

Words are meant to alter the images of your mind. The Word of God should change your outlook on life when you are fully submitted to it. When someone says "apple," do you see the word apple or do you see an apple? You see an apple, right? When someone says, "Granny Smith apple," do you see a green apple or a red apple? You see a green one, right? However, when someone says, "blue apple," your mind tilts. In the same way, when the Word of God says in Deuteronomy 28:13 that "you are the head and not the tail," you need to see yourself as an industry leader. When the Word of God says in Romans 8:37 says that "you are more than a conqueror", you need to see yourself as a winner despite your circumstances. You have to submit yourself to the Word of God and let it shape your outlook on life. Beloved, the power of imagination is for big dreamers; people who want to change the world. You can achieve a small dream without God, but big dreams are for people who want to change the world.
